### Our Mission:

Network Support Services, Inc. is committed to working with justice involved men and women in rebuilding lives that allow them to become stakeholders and contributors in their home communities.

In the United States, 67.8% of people released from incarceration return to prison within 3 years<sup>+</sup>.

In New York State, 42% return to prison within 3 years\*.

Just **5%**

### Our Work:

Network serves approximately 1,000 incarcerated and paroled men and women annually. Network provides its members intensive Cognitive Behavioral Therapeutic support, re-entry planning, access to training and job placement activities, housing, family counseling, as well as post-release cognitive behavioral therapy and connection to community-based wrap-around services in order to allow its members to rebuild their lives and to strengthen their families and their communities.

### Results:

**62%** of Network members finish school.

**27%** of Network members enter a Job Training program

**84%** of Network members are employed in Construction, Warehousing, Food Service and Green Jobs

## Our Programs:

Network builds on a 40 year history of evidence-based therapeutic programming designed to help those currently incarcerated to take responsibility for their own rehabilitation as well as support their transition back into their community.

## Network in the Prisons:

Network currently offers 400 incarcerated men and women a year the opportunity to take responsibility for their own rehabilitation through participation in therapeutic communities, life-skills programming and reentry planning.

- Our Residential Therapeutic Communities are intentional communities, members choose to live in the same housing unit and attend therapeutic and educational programs 5 days a week and help foster a supportive community amongst the members.
- Our Modular Programs provide community building activities, and the same educational and evidence-based therapeutic programs on a "drop in" basis once or twice a week for members.

## Network in the Community:

Network's reentry arm, continues to provide members with intensive cognitive behavioral therapeutic support, as well as substance-abuse prevention services, anger management, employment services, and a wide range of reentry services to over 500 parolees per year.
